



There is power in naming gifts in another person, especially when one sees the external attributes of a call to ministry emerging. As pastors and ministry leaders, you are invited to “Raise the Question”:

ASK

1x week

Once each week, ask someone a question about calling. When clergy ask questions about calling, it creates space for people to notice Holy Nudges.

“How is God calling you?”

IDENTIFY

1x month

Once each month, share how you see God at work in someone else's life. When clergy notice spiritual and natural gifts, people in the community can begin to identify them in themselves and others.

“I see God calling you...”

PREACH

1x quarter

When clergy preach on their own call, it helps others identify their own call to ministry. Once each quarter, share an example in your sermon about your call

“God called me by...”

Call Stories from Scripture as a sermon
or Bible study text:

Moses (Exodus 3:1-10)

Samuel (1 Samuel 3:1-10)

Isaiah (Isaiah 6:1-8)

Jacob (Genesis 32:24-30)

First Disciples (Luke 5:2-11)

Gideon's Call (Judges 6:11-16)

Esther (Esther 4:12-17)
